HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOUR APPROACH TO PATIENT CARE?

I've found, in my 27 years of experience, that the best approach is one that integrates the diligent pursuit of surgical excellence with understanding, sensitivity and kindness.

WHAT DOES A CONSULTATION WITH YOU ENTAIL?

After listening carefully and discussing all available options, I use modern imaging techniques as a visual tool to show patients what we can accomplish. Repeat one-on-one visits and reviewing before-and-after photos are also part of the experience.

WHERE DO YOU PERFORM SURGICAL PROCEDURES?

Surgical procedures are performed at the Encino Surgicenter, a state-of-the-art, Medicare- and AAAASF-approved freestanding center, located adjacent to my office.

WHAT IS THE RECOVERY LIKE AFTER A MACS-LIFT?

Since a MACS-Lift can be performed under local anesthesia without post-surgical drains, the recovery time is more pleasant than patients expect. Patients can go home immediately following surgery, facilitating an easy recovery, without extended downtime.


Innovative techniques

Dr. Sanders is very excited to introduce breast-augmentation imaging into his practice. "We use computer software so patients can see what a given breast implant would look like," says Dr. Sanders, who also uses imaging technology for patients desiring rhinoplasty. A proponent of remaining on the leading-edge, Dr. Sanders delivers results that turn back the clock, with protocols that help reduce post-surgical discomfort. "I try to avoid drains during tummy tucks, favoring pain pumps to keep patients comfortable." Similarly, when rejuvenating faces, Dr. Sanders believes that a less-is-more approach may be in a patient's best interest. "When appropriate, we can utilize lasers and injectables to restore youth." However, when aging symptoms are more pronounced, a lift may be needed. In this case, Dr. Sanders may recommend a modified facelift procedure known as a MACS-Lift. "Patients with loss of elasticity, sagging necklines and jowling, but who aren't ready for a full facelift, may be proper candidates."

To help this 62-year-old patient tighten slack skin in the lower third of her face, Dr. Sanders combined multiple procedures, performing a chin tuck and augmentation, coupled with a MACS-Lift—a facelift technique that helps tighten skin in the lower face and neck region by suspending underlying tissues. "Both the patient and I are very pleased with the result. She looks younger, with a marked correction of the drooping tissues."
